Terms and conditions

Storyboard category

1. The Storyboard Category forms part of the Childnet Film Competition 2022, organised by Childnet International.
2. The Storyboard Category is open to all young people within the UK, aged 7–18. Young people can enter the primary age section (ages 7–11) or the secondary age section (ages 11–18).
3. An educator/parent/carer must sign the entry form on behalf of entrants. Only entrants entered with the signed entry form will be considered for the competition.
4. The named adult on the entry form agrees to be the main point of contact on behalf of the entrant.
5. All storyboards' entries must be returned with a signed entry forms by **5pm on Wednesday 8th June 2022**. All items should be emailed to film@childnet.com
6. We can accept one storyboard entry per entrant.
7. All storyboards must be between 6 and 12 frames.
8. All storyboard content must reflect the theme of the category.
9. All storyboard content must feature a positive message and contain appropriate content and imagery.
10. The emphasis of the Storyboard Category is on the message that you share. However, we ask you to submit drawings or images of a high enough standard for us to understand the story structure.
11. All storyboarding must be the work of the young person entering the competition.
12. To ensure content and copyright terms are adhered to before entering the Storyboard Category of the Childnet Film Competition, all entries must be overseen by the named adult on the entry form.
13. The winning storyboards in both the 7–11 and 11–18 age categories will be announced online on Wednesday 13th July 2022.
14. The winning storyboard entries will feature on the Childnet website and be shared via Childnet's social media and the Safer Internet Centre website.
15. The prize for the winner of the Storyboard category is separate to the prizes given for films entered into the Childnet Film Competition. This will be an individual prize of relevant art equipment. See the website for more information.
